- **Low Flow Toilets:** Low-flow toilets can save you money by using less water. To be considered a low-flow

toilet, it must use 1.6 gallons of water or less per flush. Most toilets use 3.5 – 5 gallons per flush, or about 20 gallons per person, per day! That is more water than any household appliance. New designs have improved performance, and our plumbers can advise you on the best low-flow toilets to cut down on water usage, and lower your water bill.

- **Dual Flush Toilets:** Dual-flush toilets can save water and money. They are built to only use the water required by developing a two-button flush system; a half flush for liquid waste and a full flush for solid waste. Most modern dual-flush toilets use less than a gallon of water.
- **Pressure-Assist Toilets:** Best suited for commercial use or in homes with poor drainpipe carry, these models use the pressure of the water supply to the toilet to compress air in an inner tank. When you flush the toilet, pressurized water is forced into the bowl, blasting waste down the drainpipe.
